# **Aspen Elementary Land Trust Plan 2023-24**

# Goal #1

RISE:

Proficiency in grades 3 - 6 will meet or exceed the District average in Language Arts. And the Median Growth Percentile will meet or exceed the District average.

(Proficiency last year: LA District 43% Aspen 34.4%)

(MGP last year: District 50, Aspen 40.5)

Acadience:

Grades K-6: 60% of students will make typical or better progress at EOY Acadience testing.

Kindergarten: 55% of BOY students on red will NOT be on red at EOY First grade: 42% of BOY students on red will NOT be on red at EOY. Second grade: Maintain students on green and blue from BOY to EOY.

#### Measurement:

RISE data (proficiency and median growth percentile) Acadience data (proficiency and typical progress)

### **Action Plan Steps:**

- 1. Walk-to-Read daily interventions based on diagnostic data.
- 2. Heggerty Phonics daily practice in K-3.
- 3. All K-3 teachers will receive LETRS training.
- 4. Really Great Reading Tier 1 instruction in grades K-3 and MSRC daily practice in grades 4-6.
- 5. Tier 1 instruction targeted to meet the needs of each student including ML students.
- 6. Students will be reading text 90+ minutes every day.
- 7. Daily progress checks and official progress monitoring of students receiving interventions and ongoing monitoring of students on or above grade level in grades K-6.

## **Planned Expenditures:** \$44,000

Salaries and Benefits (teachers, aides, specialists, productivity, substitutes)

· Aides will be hired to assist teachers and students with instruction, progress monitoring, and interventions to help them accomplish this goal. Bilingual aides will also be hired to support our students learning English.

last year: Math District 38% Aspen 34.7%)

The Median Growth Percentile will meet or exceed our previous year's MGP of 55.

RISE data for proficiency and MGP.

**Action Plan Steps:** 

1. All students will have access to strong Tier I daily instruction.

2. Students will receive one-on-one and small group interventions for skill deficits.

3. Students will have the opportunity to learn from and practice with multiple teachers

and aides.

4. Online tools and resources will be used such as Think Central and teacher-selected

math software programs.

5. Students will have multiple opportunities to practice and demonstrate mastery of the

essential standards.

- 1. All students will have access to strong Tier I daily instruction.
- 2. Students will receive one-on-one and small group interventions for skill deficits.
- 3. Students will have the opportunity to learn from and practice with multiple teachers and aides.
- 4. Students will have multiple opportunities to practice and demonstrate mastery of the essential standards.
