- 3) Positive Behavior Plan
 - a) Behavior Expectation Matrix
 - b) BEST Team: meet monthly to work on challenges,
 - Being Proactive to teach behaviors by teaching expectations and behaviors rather than just issuing consequences when expectations are not met, and attendance promoted
 - d) Expectations shared at beginning of the year and will be reiterated after Winter break

- e) Hallway expectations are new, stickers awarded for good hallway behavior

- h) Attendance is such a struggle, we are constantly working on this. Chronic absence (less than 80% attendance) is about 5% of the Aspen population.
 - i) Can we gather more data about why students are missing so we can help improve these absences? Can we then put together some interventions?
