- 3) Safe Walking Route/School Safety
 - a) Renewed in January and posted on website
 - b) Safety drills every month
 - i) Active shooter drill ocurred with teachers before school started. Every classroom door is locked at all times. Teachers

cannot keep a magnet in the door jam, but they can keep the door open or closed. This is because no shooter has ever penetrated a locked door in historical active shooter situations. More training for teachers on Sep 26th.

- (1) Sarah asked about the process for release of students in an intruder situation.
- (2) Suzie answered: Police will arrive on the scene immediately. Once the building is cleared, a check-out system will take place where students are released to parents individually, midday. If a disaster occured in the building and reunification had to happen outside of the building, reunification will happen at Highland Park in the Pickle ball courts. Jordan district will handle communications through email and parent square.
